It was felt as that riders do sign waivers stating that they ride at their own risk it is up to the rider to decide whether to continue riding after a fall, not the Committee. However, as a number of our members are registered nurses we feel confident that “if in doubt – sit them out” EA protocols would automatically be followed. Cathy Smith will look at creating a suitable form which will be left with the First Aid kit.</li> <li>• Sue Berry advised that official test results have been sent to Equestrian Australia.</li> <li>• Hetty Munda sent out an email to all members on 1<sup>st</sup> June reminding them “that the EDA does not tolerate any form of bullying and disrespectful behaviour towards other riders, spectators and especially volunteers as without them we would not have a Club.”</li> </ul> <p>Moved by: Hetty Munda that Correspondence In &amp; Out be accepted. However if you do have a bridle number, it must be shown on both sides of the horse.</li> <li>• The Committee raised the issue of whether all riders are aware of whether their helmets are compliant with EA standards. Although details of this are already on our website, Hetty will email all members to remind them of this.</li> <li>• Gear checking – it appears that a number of competitors are unsure whether their gear is compliant with EA standards.
